




CIDREE 2022 Conference/GA

General information:

- In Norway, we use the Norwegian kroner as our currency (nok, or kr). The rate is approximately 10.3 NOK to 1 EUR. Norway is very much cashless, so do not worry about taking out cash from an ATM. Cards (VISA/Mastercard) are accepted everywhere, so you will not need cash.

Transfer from Oslo airport to the city


The easiest way to get from the Oslo Gardermoen Airport (OSL) to the hotel is by train; the airport train "Flytoget" takes about 20 minutes and leaves every 10 minutes. You



can buy tickets in the arrivals hall of the Oslo airport. A one-way ticket costs 210nok (about 21 EUR).

Take the train to the Oslo Central station, and the hotel is about a 500m, 5-minute walk from there.


If you would like to walk together, please meet in the hotel lobby at 8.30, and **Hedda** will walk over with you.





The Directorate is a short 500m walk from the hotel. There is a bridge ("The Acrobat bridge") that goes from a plaza across the street from the hotel over the train tracks, and will take you to a plaza right next to the Directorate's office. Your route looks like this:

(yellow is the hotel, blue is the Directorate office, and red is the route over the bridge):



The bridge looks like this:



Once you cross the bridge, go down the stairs, and make a right to walk around the building. The entrance to the Directorate is on the south side of the building, facing the train tracks (not the north side. If you see the entrance to the Oslo Police Immigration Section, you're on the wrong side).





The correct entrance looks like this:



When you arrive, there will be a badge with your name at the reception desk.
